PERPETUAL TROPHIES CRITERIA

UPDATED: 26 November 2020

Note: To be eligible for Perpetual Trophies South Australian Masters Clubs and One Clubs affiliation must be current with MSSA and meet all affiliation requirements. Individual Swimmers must be financial members of MSA / MSSA and members of an Affiliated South Australian Masters Swimming Club or One Club.

SHORT COURSE/LONG COURSE LONG DISTANCE SHIELD

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the club that gains the highest points in the Short Course/Long Course Long Distance Meet
- Runner Up Trophy – Awarded to the club that gains the second to highest points in the Short Course/Long Course Long Distance Meet

LONG COURSE STATE CUP

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the club that gains the highest points in the Long Course State Cup
- Runner Up Trophy – Awarded to the club that gains the second to highest points in the Long Course State Cup

SHORT COURSE STATE CUP

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the club that gains the highest points in the Short Course State Cup
- Runner Up Trophy – Awarded to the club that gains the second to highest points in the Short Course State Cup

INTERCLUB SHIELD

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the club that gains the highest points in the Interclub Series
- Runner Up Trophy – Awarded to the club that gains the second to highest points in the Interclub Series

INTERCLUB RELAY SHIELD

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the club that gains the highest points in Relay Events in the Interclub Series
- Runner Up Trophy – Awarded to the club that gains the second to highest points in Relay Events in the Interclub Series

INTERCLUB PROFICIENCY AWARD

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the club with the highest percentage for the Interclub Series
- Runner Up Trophy – Awarded the club with the second to highest percentage for the Interclub Series

Total Points gained by the club in the Interclub Series divided by the number of swimmers registered with this club as at the end of September of the year when the Interclub Series occurred.

PERPETUAL TROPHIES CRITERIA

SUMMER POOL SERIES CUP

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the club that gains the highest points in the Summer Pool Series
- Runner Up Trophy – Awarded to the club that gains the second to highest points in the Summer Pool Series

SUMMER POOL SERIES PROFICIENCY AWARD

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the club with the highest percentage for the Summer Pool Series
- Runner Up Trophy – Awarded the club with the second highest percentage for the Summer Pool Series

Total Points gained by the club in the Summer Pool Series divided by the number of swimmers registered with this club as at the end of March of the year when the Summer Pool Series occurred.

OPEN WATER SWIM AGGREGATE TROPHY

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the club that gains the highest aggregate points in the Open Water Swim Series
- Runner Up Trophy – Awarded to the club that gains the second to highest aggregate points in the Open Water Swim Series

Each Swimmer receives points in each Gender and Age Group for every OWS swim:

- 5 points for 1st in Age Group
- 4 points for 2nd in Age Group
- 3 points for 3rd in Age Group
- 2 points for 4th in Age Group
- 1 point for each swimmer from then on in Age Group

OPEN WATER SWIM PRESENTATION – TOWELS

For all Competitors completing all Open Water Swims for the Series with the exception of the OWS Event Coordinators and one other key Officer nominated by the Organising Club prior to the swim will receive credit for their swim.

POOL SWIM PRESENTATION – TOWELS

All swimmers completing all pool swims on the program during the calendar year. (N.B. The transition to a calendar year occurs in 2022 so swims from November 1st 2021 to December 2022 will be included. After that it will be calendar year).

PATRONS CUP (ENDURANCE 1000)

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the club that gains the highest points per member average within the Endurance specifications
- Runner Up Trophy – Awarded to the club that gains the second to highest points per member average within the Endurance specifications

This Award is completed by clubs adding swimmer's swims to a portal on the Masters Swimming Australia website under Endurance 1000 which then calculates the points.

PERPETUAL TROPHIES CRITERIA

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the Swimmer that gains the highest points for records set at the two MSSA State Cups
- Runner Up Trophy - Awarded to the Swimmer that gains the second to highest points for records set at the two MSSA State Cups

For this award swimmers earn points for records broken in the two State Cups - Points gained for State Records (5pts) and National Records (10pts)

FEMALE SWIMMER OF THE YEAR

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the Swimmer who gains the highest points for records set at all Masters Meets
- Runner Up Trophy – The swimmer who gains the second highest points for records set at all masters meets.

Awarded to the female swimmer that gains the most national and state records for the calendar year. Points are gained for State Records (1pt), National Records (5pts) and World Records (10pts) obtained in the above year.

MALE SWIMMER OF THE YEAR

- Winning Trophy - Awarded to the Swimmer who gains the highest points for records set at all Masters Meets
- Runner Up Trophy – The swimmer who gains the second highest points for records set at all masters meets.

Awarded to the male swimmer that gains the most national and state records for the calendar year. Points are gained for State Records (1pt), National Records (5pts) and World Records (10pts) obtained in the above year.

INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS FOR FEMALES AND MALES

Awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place female and male swimmers for the Interclub Series in each Age Group.

INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS FOR FEMALES AND MALES

Awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place female and male swimmers for the Summer Pool Series in each Age Group.
