



Criteria for the Award of Masters Swimming South Australia (MSSA) Life Member

LIFE MEMBERS

Life Membership is the highest honour that can be bestowed by MSSA for longstanding and valued service to Masters level swimming in South Australia. Life Membership can be considered after 10 years distinguished contribution with sustained excellence to MSSA.

NOMINATIONS

- An Affiliated Member may nominate a person for Life Membership by notice in writing to the Board at least 68 days prior to the Annual General Meeting.
- A nomination must include a detailed written submission outlining the history of outstanding services of the nominee to MSSA (not a club).
- The nominee must be a MSSA member at the time of service but can be nominated up to two years after membership ceases.
- The nomination must be seconded by at least one other MSSA affiliated club.

PROCESS

- A vote on the Award will be made by special resolution at a subsequent Board meeting, with a majority required.
- Awards will normally be made at the annual MSSA Presentation Dinner. However, if this is inconvenient, can be made at another time agreed by the Board.
- The Award will consist of an inscribed trophy or plaque and a certificate signed by the MSSA Chairperson, or other items as agreed by the Board. The cost will be met by the MSSA.
